RULES - Mary Willenborg- If you hit into the ice plant on the left of #3, she suggests that it is best to hit a provisional ball in case you do not find your first ball. If you do find the first ball, you can hit it if possible, or declare it unplayable. If you declare it unplayable, you can take two club lengths from where the ball lies. You can use your longest club for measuring. If the two club lengths put you in the middle of the cart path, then you can take relief from the cart path on the right side of the cart path. If you just barely get on the cart path, then your relief is on the left side, which may leave you still in the ice plant. If that is the case, then you can go back to the tee box and hit. Once you find your original ball, then your provisional ball cannot be played.
