GENERAL MEETING
MARCH 6, 2014

Board members present were Patrice King, President; Val Mitchell, Vice President; Jill Cagle, Secretary, Anne Greenwood, Treasurer; JoAnn Robinson, Tournament; Terry Moher, Handicap; Marilyn Small, Membership.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00. There was a motion to approve the minutes from the February meeting. The motion was seconded and approved.

PRESIDENT – Patrice King asked members to be sure to arrive for check in on time. Time is 7:30 for new members and 7:45 for all others.

The Board suggested having a third member on the check in desk. It was decided to leave it up to the discretion of the monthly chairs. Patrice suggested that long-standing members work the desk with new members. Also, more copies of the pairing sheet will be put out and the pairings table will be moved to better accommodate members checking in. She reminded members to call the monthly chairs if you want to play and have not played the previous week.

VICE PRESIDENT – Val Mitchell reported that the Partner's Eclectic Tournament luncheon will be on March 20. Anita Thibault and Loretta Bertrand will bring dessert. Cost for lunch is \$10.00, which includes a soft drink.

TOURNAMENT – JoAnn Robinson reported that holes 17 and 18 were cart path only today. 50 people have signed up for the Partner's Eclectic. Check in on the first tournament day is from 7:00 a.m. to 7:45 a.m. Judging of the carts will be on March 20 at 7:30 a.m. The cut off to sign up is this Saturday, 3/8/14. There cannot be more than 10 strokes difference in partner's handicaps.

There was a rules clarification on chip ins. and closest to the pin. Once a player's ball has been on the green and putted off of the green, there are no further chances for a chip in. Closest to the pin must be completed in the first 2 strokes from the tee box to the green.

In team play a player must pay \$2.00. If not paid the player and their partner will not be in the game. JoAnn asked for comments on paying an entrance fee for tournaments. It was moved by Babe Carreon and seconded by Anna Nathanson to pay a \$5.00 tournament fee for tournaments occurring after the Partner's Eclectic in 2014. It was approved by majority vote.

TREASURER – Anne Greenwood. The checkbook is in balance with the bank. \$155.87 has been used for expenses. \$134.00 in deposits.

HANDICAP – Terry Moher attended a WPLGA meeting. She asked about flight determination and was told that it is up to the discretion of the club. She will keep 4 flights as even as possible according to handicaps.

MEMBERSHIP – Marilyn Small. We now have 70 members. New members are Sheila Gebhardt, Nancy Parrish and Rosa Conk.
