

SHORECLIFFS WOMEN'S GOLF CLUB
GENERAL MEETING MINUTES
APRIL 3, 2014

Board members present:

President, Patrice King; Vice President, Val Mitchell; Secretary, Jill Cagle; Treasurer, Anne Greenwood; Tournament, JoAnn Robinson and Cheryl Waters; Handicap, Terry Moher; Membership, Marilyn Small.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 am.

PRESIDENT: Patrice King reported to the members that the Board would like to eliminate the inactive membership status. The cost difference is \$25.00 more per year for active members than inactive members. Inactive members pay to WPLGA. They cannot play in SWGC tournaments but regular Thursday play is OK. We currently have 3 inactive members. A vote was taken to eliminate the inactive status from SWGC starting in 2015. It was approved.

VICE PRESIDENT: Val thanked everyone for a nice lunch following the Partner's Eclectic. Anita Thibault was thanked for donating the DJ. May 15, 2014 is the Club Championship tournament luncheon. It will be a BBQ. Members do not have to participate in the tournament to attend the luncheon. Val will begin collecting money for the luncheon on 4/23/14. Members must have attended 2 General Meetings and played 8 games this year on regular play days to qualify. A posted status of where you stand from the past year will be on the bulleting board.

There was a discussion regarding whether the closest to the pin should be flighted. The Board decided that it created unnecessary work and that members of SWGC get 2 strokes to make closest to the pin. It will not be implemented.

Cheryl reported that Mary Willenborg, Rules Chair, asks members to be sure that if your ball enters the V ditch on hole 16 a ball should be dropped on the top. Members should be sure to drop where the ball entered the V ditch not where it stops.

The Mixer with the Men's Club will be on June 16 or 24, which are Tuesdays. The Men's Club will decide the date. Our members had no preference.

Joe Leight discussed Pace of Play and Cart Driving Guidelines:

PACE OF PLAY:

1. Don't drive where it is not authorized
2. If you are half a hole or more behind the foursome in front of you, play ready golf. Leave the green as soon as you and your partner have putted out.
3. Drop your partner at her ball and then go to your ball.
4. It should take 4 hours and 30 minutes to play 18 holes.

CART DRIVING GUIDELINES:

1. Observe the 90 degree rule at all times.
2. Please avoid driving through ALL wet areas. Do NOT drive over or remove any ropes and stakes.
3. Use caution when entering and exiting fairways over curbs, please drive SLOWLY over all curbs
4. Keep off of Hole #6 and Hole #16 entirely.
5. Do not drive the cart on the fringe of any greens, and do not drive the cart between the green and the sand traps. No one likes hitting chip shots out of cart tracks.

Joe reminded us that we would be ticketed if we park in the red zones in the parking lot. These are put there by the fire department.

50/50 winners were Peggy Kapuzky and Joan Corbin. Michele Torrey won the free round of golf.
