TOURNAMENT: Jo Ann reported that the deadline for sign ups for the Club Championship tournament will be this coming Monday, 5/5/14. There will be a \$5.00 tournament fee that will only be used for prize money. The \$5.00 will be collected on Thursday, 5/8/14. She asked that members please have the correct change. Members following the field during the tournament must designate the days they will be playing when signing up. There is going to be a hat-decorating contest. The hats will be judged on Thursday, 5/8/14 and prizes will be awarded at the luncheon on 5/15/14. Members are asked to wear their hats the first day of the tournament and bring them the day of the luncheon. Members who are participating in the tournament must play all 3 days. The tournament is stroke play. Members will post all 3 days. Ringers can be posted the first and last days of the tournament. An individual score card and a master scorecard will be kept. Accumulative scores will be recorded all three days. Prizes will be paid to low gross and low net all 3 days.

PUBLICITY: Leslie Nolan will take pictures of the hat creations for the Club Championship Tournament.

RULES: Mary Willenborg reported that on hole 16, it is fairplay up to the O.B. stakes on the left. We can hit out of there but may not ground our club. There are hazard stakes on both sides of the fairway. The ditch on the left is not a hazard. If you hit to the left of the ditch, in the hazard, you can bring the ball across the ditch onto the fairway and take a penalty stroke. You cannot stand on the cart path if you take relief, only if no relief is taken. You get one club length relief off of the cart path.

To take relief from an immovable obstruction (man made object) the player must lift the ball and drop it, without penalty, within one club length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief. The nearest point of relief must not be in a hazard or on a putting green. When the ball is dropped within one club length of the nearest point of relief, the ball must first strike a part of the course at a spot that avoids interference by the immovable obstruction and is not in a hazard and not on a putting green.

Reminder that June 17 is the Pit Bulls and Poodles tournament. It is \$40.00.

Phyllis Carroll won the free round of golf. Karen Devlin and Glee Draper each won \$25.00 for the 50/50 drawing.
