PRESIDENT: Val called the meeting to order at 8:04.

VICE PRESIDENT: The Partner's Eclectic luncheon will be a St. Patrick's Day theme. Soup and sandwiches will be served. The luncheon price no longer includes a non-alcoholic beverage. Today Mary and Caryl will collect \$10 from the members who are attending the luncheon.

TOURNAMENT: Michele asked if there were anymore members who wanted to sign up for the Partner's Eclectic. It will be a St. Patrick's theme. Players will be given the rules the first day of the tournament. One partner must hole out. A \$5.00 entry fee will be charged. The ringer will be posted the first day only. Tee off will be 8:30 am the first day and 8:00 am the second day. Appetizers will be served after play on the first day.

The members were reminded that March 31, 2016 is guest day.

MEMBERSHIP: The Standing Rules Membership qualifications will be changed to read as follows:

Standing Rule #1

To become a member of SWGC an applicant must be 18 years of age and meet qualification requirements. After qualifying, a prospective member must submit an application and club fees to the membership chairwoman. A new member's dues will be prorated if joining the club after July 1. All dues are non refundable.

Standing Rule #2

Prospective members must qualify with a maximum score of 117. Within a two month period she may play as a guest on three regular SWGC days to meet the requirement. She may also qualify with a member of Shorecliffs on a non regular play day. She must present the handicap chairwoman with her qualifying score card attested to by her and the club member with whom she played. If a score of 117 is not met during the three guest play days or on a non regular play day with a current SWGC member, a prospective member may not play as a qualifying guest for a period of three months.

Standing Rule #6

A maximum score of 10 should be recorded on any hole during qualifying.

A discussion followed. The motion to change the Membership Standing rule as read was moved, seconded and approved by a member vote.

HANDICAP: Terry explained that the red tees for hole 16 are to be replaced with temporary markers beginning today. It was brought to the attention of Terry that non SWGC members who play on Thursday are posting incorrectly because the red tees are left back where we play and not moved forward for non SWGC players to use after we play. The remedy to this is to place temporary red tees for our club's use only on the back red tee on hole 16. The tees will be place by the first SWGC group and picked up by the last SWGC group.
